Dr. Salim S. Abdool Karim and Dr. Quarraisha Abdool Karim founded the Centre for the AIDS Programme of Research in South Africa (CAPRISA) in Durban, South Africa in 2002. CAPRISA has made various achievements in the field of HIV/AIDS, including research on early introduction of ART for patients co-infected with HIV/TB and antiviral vaginal drugs for HIV prevention.

In addition to their global contribution to improving HIV/AIDS prevention and treatment, they have greatly contributed to training African researchers and leading the COVID-19 response in Africa.

In recognition of these achievements, Prime Minister KISHIDA awarded them the 4th Hideyo Noguchi Africa Prize (in the field of medical research) in 2022.

At this event, we hope to openly exchange lessons learnt from the HIV/AIDS and COVID-19 responses and how they can be applied to the next pandemic.
